

NOTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC VIOLATION

The Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986 requires that commercial drivers notify their employer and the state that issued their license of all moving violations, including those committed in a personal vehicle, for which the driver forfeited collateral or was convicted, within 30 days after conviction. See reverse for listing of state agency addresses.
